# **Spectator Information:**

- No outside food allowed. Concessions will be available on site.
- Quarterfinal game admission will be \$10.00 each day.
- Tickets will be available at GoFan.co
- Clear bag policy for spectators.

# **Team Information:**

- The team on the TOP of the bracket is the designated home team and must wear WHITE jerseys.
- The team on the BOTTOM of the bracket is the visiting team and must wear DARK jerseys.
- No outside food is allowed. Concessions will be available on site.
- Dressing rooms are available for restroom and half-time ONLY. Please arrive ready to play.
- Only the starting lineups will be announced (not entire roster).
- There will be 25 chairs on the sidelines. There is a maximum number of 20 players in uniform.
- Warmups allowed only in the time immediately following the previous game (no warmup at halftime of previous game and no shootarounds at host facility in advance).
- The pregame conference will include head coaches, game administrators, and officials.
- There are no hospitality rooms available.
- Teams need to bring their own towels, bottled water, and ice if needed.

Schools will have the option to broadcast games via live stream or radio. NOTE: With change to neutral quarterfinal sites, the following information differs slightly from what may have previously been distributed.



On January 11, 2007 Itawamba Community College debuted its \$15.6 million Davis Event Center in front of more than 2,000 fans. The Lady Indians basketball team defeated Holmes in the first game at the new state-of-the-art facility.

Named for Itawamba Community College basketball coaching legends Windle (Buster) Davis and Kindle (Bud) Davis, the Davis Event Center houses all basketball operations for both the men's and women's basketball teams, including dressing rooms, training rooms and coaches' offices. The Event Center, which also hosts graduation ceremonies and concerts, has a fixed chair-back seating capacity of 2,800 and can expand that capacity to 3,500 with the pull-out seating
