YOUNG CHILD SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (YCSEP)

Ages 4-9

UNC's Young Child Summer Enrichment Program for high-ability learners, ages 4 through 9 provides a unique learning opportunity. The program curriculum is designed specifically for students who show exceptional talents and abilities. It incorporates creativity and problem solving, while teaching students highlevel thinking skills based upon their interests and passions. This two-week session is offered mornings Monday through Friday of both weeks.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (SEP)

Rising 5th – 10th Graders

Enrich your student's summer with UNC's two-week residential program for gifted, talented, creative and high-ability learners entering 5th through 10th grades. Students will participate in stimulating academic experiences and fun social activities developed by gifted education specialists. Classes in this popular, affordable program are held on the UNC campus and trained camp counselors provide supervision during all non-class time.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (SEP) DAY PROGRAM

Rising 5th – 7th Graders

We have a limited number of spots available this year for 5th, 6th and 7th graders who would like to attend SEP day classes rather than the full residential program. Students will attend SEP from approximately 8:15 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday (both weeks) and on Super Saturday (at the end of the first week of the program). Students will participate in morning classes, lunch, and afternoon classes and will have the option to attend the Banquet the final Thursday night of the program.

LEADERSHIP ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (LEP)

Rising 11th and 12th Graders

The Leadership Enrichment Program (LEP) is designed for students who will be entering the 11th and 12th grades in Fall 2020. These students will learn to use their gifts and talents to develop leadership skills. Students participate in leadership seminars, assist a teacher in an SEP class and work on special LEP activities. LEP is for students with leadership potential who want to learn more about leadership skills in an active environment.
