 - County wide start and stop times In South Bryan, we are proposing a tier change with RHMS and the three in town elementary schools (RHPS, CES,

- and RHES). This will help with classroom coverage requirements and instructional needs at the middle school. Also, it should help with traffic flow when commuting to our elementary schools.
- North Bryan operations and South Bryan operations. Mr. Clark will run the north end and Dr. Cox will run the south end. Both operations departments will include bus drivers and maintenance workers. There will also be a grounds crew that will be shared county wide that will work on a rotation schedule to visit each school on a set day.
- Pathways to Success we will propose a new curriculum at BCHS that offers an alternative pathway to graduation.

IV. FY 18 Budget Discussion

- The law now requires us to have two public hearings on the budget. We are required to provide a summary of our budget and be able to provide an electronic copy of a line item when requested. We will hold our public hearings in May before the called work session on the 16th and before the board meeting on the 25th.
- Our proposed budget includes the Governor's 2% salary increase

- The budget includes an increase in substitute teacher compensation.
