- **TRI-VALLEY TO HOST FREE HEART SCREENINGS**

We are excited to announce the [Young Hearts for Life](#) EKG screening program is once again coming to our school on **Wednesday, April 8th**. This EKG screens for risk factors associated with sudden cardiac death (SCD) and we want to give every student at Tri-Valley an opportunity for this **free** screening. The EKGs are read onsite by a cardiologist specially trained in identifying risk factors of SCD. In order for your son/daughter to participate, they must be registered before **March 20th**. Select Tri-Valley *in the form* under the school drop down. Save your confirmation email as you will need it to open screening results. Please make sure you sign up by March 20th!
