Memorial Plaza and Track Project

We are excited to announce the Blue Ridge Memorial Plaza and Track project! Community members from Bellflower, Farmer City, and Mansfield, met in Fall 2018 to develop plans for a Memorial Plaza and Track Complex at Blue Ridge High School. The Memorial Plaza is intended to honor the history of all of the schools that make up the current school district, and to highlight and enhance the Kenneth Rittenhouse Memorial Arch so that its significance is remembered.

For many years, school and community groups have expressed interest in an all-weather track at Blue Ridge High School. The track would benefit several activities, including boys and girls Track and Field, Band, Cheerleading, Football, and Soccer. BRHS could host track meets and band competitions. Community members could use the track for exercise.

Efforts are underway to raise \$1.1 million in donations to fund the Memorial Plaza and Track Complex. A detailed brochure is at <https://5il.co/as3q>. We plan to raise funds over this next year and install the track in 2021. Contributions are tax deductible and can be made out to “Blue Ridge Schools Track Complex”.
