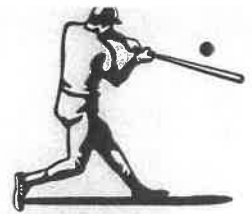

The Seneca East Baseball Club offers various levels of competition for our youth. They include:

County A, B, & C: ages 8-12 - teams travel and play other teams throughout the county. The skill level increases at each level.

Pony League: for players 13 -14 (15 if currently in 8th grade - copy of grade card will be needed)

Any player 8-12 will be placed on a county league team if requested.**

Requests for players to play for certain coaches will ONLY be granted to keep immediate family members together.

REGISTRATION FEES:

Tee-Ball: \$25/player
Town League/A/B/C: \$50/player
Pony League: \$60/player
Family Rate: \$80 maximum *Family rate does not apply to Pony League and Girls Softball

Uniforms (hats/tee-shirts, etc.) will be provided by the SE Ball Club. No player, coach, or team may wear other uniforms or uniform upgrades for games without prior authorization of the SE Ball Club.

AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE FORM

Even though there are not many accidents in baseball, I am aware that playing or practicing baseball can lead to a number of injuries. I understand that the risks in baseball include, but are not limited to, minor and serious injuries to most bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, eyes, and injuries which may result in some form of paralysis, and even death. Further, I realize that besides the possible injuries mentioned, I may suffer various degrees of impairment to my future abilities to earn a living, participate in social and recreational activities, and enjoy life.

The risks from which injury may result with baseball include, but are not limited to, being struck by a batted or thrown ball, having a collision with a player or fence, being spiked, being hit or tripping over bats, balls, or dislodged equipment, and having dirt, grass, or dust lodged in ones eyes. Due to the risk of injury involved, I recognize the importance of following coaches' instructions regarding, but not limited to playing and practicing techniques, training and team rules, and to obey such instructions.

By signing statement, you, as the player, acknowledge that you read it, understood it, and agree to follow the rules and regulations of your coach and of the **Seneca East Baseball Club**. Additionally, your signature affirms that you are in good physical health and know of no condition or reason that you should not participate.
