

## AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

FEBRUARY, 2020

Applications for the following scholarships are now available in the Guidance Office. If you feel that you meet the eligibility requirements and are interested in applying, come by the Guidance Office. Applications are on file in the College Information Section for the following:

**NAME: CENTRAL ARKANSAS SPHINX FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

Three scholarships will be awarded to African American males who demonstrate commitment to education, high ethical standards, outstanding leadership ability, and participation in community and other extracurricular activities. Financial need is also considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by March 2, 2020

**NAME: COLLEGE COVERED**

CollegeCovered.com is a free resource to help plan and pay for college. You can enter to win a \$5,000 scholarship at Scholarship.CollegeCovered.Com. Twelve scholarships will be awarded by random drawing nationwide.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: None given

**NAME: HENRY LEE GILKEY SCHOLARSHIP**

To apply, you must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and an ACT score of 19 or higher. An essay between 500 and 1,000 words on the assigned topic is required as well as community service, and letters of recommendation.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by March 1, 2020

**NAME: THE HENDERSON BLOCK SCHOLARSHIP**

To apply, you must be planning to attend UCA in the fall and have a cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or better. An essay on the topic given is required. Apply online at <https://uca.campuslabs.com/engage/submitter/form/start/356834>.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Online by April 1, 2020

**NAME: JAMES HUMPHREY JR. SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

This scholarship will be awarded based on financial need, recommendations, an essay and you must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Rec'd by April 15, 2020

**NAME: IMAGINE PAUL MITCHELL PARTNER SCHOOL**

Paul Mitchell will hold a Preview Day on November 8, 2019, and will waive the application fee during that day only. To apply, you will need to take \$20 for the State Board fee, unofficial transcript, driver's license and social security card and write an essay on why you want to pursue a career in beauty. You can also apply for a \$1,000 scholarship. For the \$100 application fee to be waived, you must attend the Preview Day.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: June 1, 2020

**NAME: THE IVY FOUNDATION OF LITTLE ROCK**

The Foundation will be awarding several scholarships to African-American women who will be attending a four-year college or university. To apply, you must have a 3.0 or better minimum cumulative GPA, a 19 composite score on the ACT, display high ethical standards, outstanding leadership ability and participation in community/extracurricular activities. Financial need is also taken into consideration.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Postmarked by February 24, 2020

The Ivy Foundation will also be awarding two \$2,000 scholarships to African-American males who plan to attend a four-year college/university. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required along with documented community service participation, financial need and a letter of recommendation.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Postmarked by February 24, 2020

**NAME: SILAS CARNEAL JONES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

To apply, you must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater and an ACT scores of at least 18. You must also be planning to attend a 4-year college/university or a vocational-technical school.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by February 14, 2020

**NAME: PHYLLIS KINCANNON SCHOLARSHIP**

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.4 or better is required along with community service and extracurricular activities. A 150 word essay is required on the topic "Why my Vote is Important".

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by March 7, 2020

**NAME: NO SWEAT SCHOLARSHIP BY CIRKLED IN**

This is a free service for students to create an electronic portfolio showcasing your skills and achievements. They will have a drawing for a \$2,500 scholarship. No GPA, no income requirements and no essay required.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Online by March 31, 2020

**NAME: NORTH PULASKI RETIRED TEACHERS ASSOCIATION**

This is a \$1,000 scholarship for students who plan to become a teacher. You must submit information of your honors, organizations and community service in which you have participated. A short essay and letters of recommendation are also required. Should you receive this scholarship, you can reapply each year you are enrolled in an Arkansas college or university.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Postmarked by February 28, 2020

**NAME: PB&J SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship will be awarded on a competitive basis to a student who has a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, exhibits strong leadership ability, good character and have a need for financial assistance.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by March 13, 2020

**NAME: RISA RATLIFF VOLUNTEER SCHOLARSHIP**

This is a volunteer based scholarship for current female seniors. You must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or

better and demonstrate outstanding volunteer performance in the Central Arkansas area.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Received by April 1, 2020

To apply, you must be an African-American graduating senior with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75. Other criteria includes participating in school/community activities, leadership ability, and good character.
