

**BARNEVELD SCHOOL DISTRICT
FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS**

This policy applies to foreign exchange students attending Barneveld High School for the full school year.

1. Foreign exchange students will not receive a Barneveld High School Diploma.
 - a. They don't need to present a complete transcript of their previous work.
 - b. They don't need to take a normal class load, but they must take at least one English and one social studies class.

2. Since foreign exchange students may have difficulty with our language, they will be considered special students.
 - a. They will be eligible for special grading
 - b. They will be permitted to go on field trips that enhance their study of American culture (foreign exchange students will pay their own expenses).
 - c. They will be granted an honorary diploma and be permitted to participate in the commencement service if they are considered seniors.

3. If foreign exchange students wish to graduate from Barneveld High School, they must fulfill the following requirements:
 - a. They must supply a complete transcript in English at the time of enrollment or shortly thereafter
 - b. They must be evaluated by the school administration and be placed as a Senior.
 - c. They must meet all graduation requirements for the State of Wisconsin and may petition the Barneveld School District for any exemption of School District requirements.
 - d. They must attend Barneveld High School for at least one full year prior to graduation.

The Barneveld School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, creed, age, national origin, ancestry, pregnancy, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or disability.
