HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT CLASSIFICATION

The Barneveld School Board desires to provide the highest quality instruction and the best results from its graduates. The following criteria are established as student classifications:

FRESHMAN – a student has been promoted from the 8th grade.

SOPHOMORE – a student has satisfactorily completed at least 6 credits.

JUNIOR – a student has completed credits in math, social studies, science, English, and has earned a minimum of 13 credits.

SENIOR – a student has completed credits in English, social studies, math, science, and has earned a minimum of 19 credits.

In order to graduate from Barneveld High School, the student must have satisfied all Barneveld graduation requirements.

If a student does not pass a required course, the student is required to re-take the class until passed.

In the event a student is failing a required course or does not have enough credits to graduate, the student and parent(s) will be notified by the end of the 3rd quarter of the senior year that the student may not graduate.

In the event the student fails (F grade) a class or receives an incomplete (“I” grade) and does not meet the district’s graduation requirements, the student will not participate in the graduation exercises. The student will receive a diploma upon satisfactory completion of the coursework and may participate in the next held graduation exercise after completion of the coursework.
