

RELIGIOUS BELIEFS ACCOMODATION

The Barneveld School Board will provide for the reasonable accommodation of a pupil's religious beliefs with regard to all examinations and other academic requirements.

This policy requires the annual written notification to all pupils, the parent or guardian of minor pupils, and instructors, of the rules and complaint process. Written notification will be provided in the Eagle Flyer annually.

Furthermore, student handbooks will specify procedures by which a pupil, parent or guardian can confidentially notify the administrator or his/her designee of potential conflicts. The handbooks will explain the means by which a pupil is permitted to make up an examination or academic requirements at another time or by an alternative means without any prejudicial effect. The district's student discrimination complaint procedure will allow for an appeal of any administrative decision.

Written acknowledgement will be made within forty-five (45) days of receipt of a written complaint and a determination will be made within ninety (90) days of receipt of the written complaint unless the parties agree to an extension of time. The complainant may file a complaint with or appeal directly to, the State Superintendent if the School Board does not comply.
