Please note that we will be returning to precovid service regulations. These regulations require:

- Food to be consumed onsite in a congregate location (cafeteria)
- Only kids ages 1-18 years old (Those with a disability and are above 18 that are participating in a school function also may participate)
- Kids must take certain items to qualify as a meal

- No adult meals will be served at the sites
- No bagged meals will be offered to anyone unless it is an approved field trip
