Alliance or Marlington High School students intending to complete one of the following programs at Stark State College are eligible to earn a \$1,000 scholarship (excluding books and fees):

## To be eligible for the program, students will need to:

Oil and Gas Technologies

- Meet admission criteria to Stark State College and be granted admission
- Complete and pass one of the following 2 year programs at Marlington or Alliance High Schools: Auto Technology, Construction Trades, Engineering, Natural Resources Energy (formerly Oil & Gas Technologies), or Welding
- Earn an overall proficient score or higher on required CTE Competency Exams (WebExams) or earn 12 or more points of State Recognized Industry Credentials.
- Be fully enrolled at Alliance or Marlington High Schools during Junior and Senior years
- Successfully complete all state and school graduation requirements by the Spring Commencement.
- Enroll as a student at Stark State College in the Summer or Fall semester immediately following graduation, and study one of the above post-secondary programs.

Students do not have to enroll at Stark State College in the Career Field program from which they graduated in High School.

 Submit one letter of recommendation from your career tech teacher. Please have him/her address academics, character, potential in career tech field
