

Trinity Episcopal Church Vocational Scholarship Guidelines

Our Mission

As an outreach opportunity, the parishioners of Trinity Episcopal Church, Alliance, seek to facilitate the path to higher learning for the local students of our neighbor, Alliance High School. Trinity Episcopal Church of Alliance, Ohio will award a \$500 scholarship to a deserving senior at Alliance High School who will attend a technical school, trade school, or a specialty training school.

Our Process

The selection process shall follow these steps:

- The scholarship will be advertised and available in the Alliance High School guidance office.
- The applicant shall submit a completed application, a transcript and letters of recommendation to the appointed person at Alliance High School.
- A committee consisting of members of Trinity may interview the applicants.
- After reviewing the applications and discussing the potential interview results, the committee shall select a scholarship recipient and present the name to vestry for approval.
- The selection shall take into account the applicants' scholastic accomplishments, potential for success and financial need.
- The priest (or priest in charge) shall announce the scholarship recipient in May at the annual Senior Awards Ceremony at Alliance High School.
- To receive the funds, the scholarship recipient must present a copy of their fall schedule from their selected institution to a member of the Trinity scholarship committee. Upon approval, the recipient will receive a check from Trinity's treasurer.
