Requirements

Applicants must have been an active member of Student Senate for at least two years (2021-22 school year does not count).

Applicants must have plans to continue their education at a college or technical school. Applicants must have maintained a 3.0 four-year cumulative GPA or higher.

Selection Criteria

The award will be based on the student's

1. Student Senate involvement
2. Service and leadership in school and community
3. Personal statement about impact of Senate
