To be eligible for the program, students will need to:

- Meet admission criteria to Stark State College and be granted admission
- Complete and pass one a 2 year Career Tech program at Marlington or Alliance High Schools: Auto Technology, Construction Trades, Engineering, Natural Resources Energy, Welding, or "other".
- Earn an overall proficient score or higher on required CTE Competency Exams (WebXams) or earn 12 or more points of State Recognized Industry Credentials.
- Be fully enrolled at Alliance or Marlington High Schools during Junior and Senior years
- Successfully complete all state and school graduation requirements by the Spring Commencement.
- Enroll as a student at Stark State College in the Summer or Fall semester immediately following graduation, and study one of the post-secondary programs listed at the top of this page.

Students do not have to enroll at Stark State College in the Career Field program from which they graduated in High School
