The following specific requirements are to be met for consideration for a Throckmorton Scholarship. Applications should include the following information and documents.

- Student must be African American or Native American
- Student must reside within Northeast Ohio or Western Pennsylvania
- Educational facility must be in Northeast Ohio or Western Pennsylvania
- Educational facility must be an accredited 4-year college/university
- A copy of your Birth Certificate
- Your contact information, home address, email
- A copy of your current College grades and GPA, or if applying as a high school senior, include your final high school transcript
- A current Financial Needs Form from the school that documents the grants, scholarships and loans you are receiving
- Current bill from the college/university
- A copy of your schedule/courses for the next semester/quarter
- Anticipated year of graduation
- Include one or more short paragraphs describing:
 - Why you should be considered for a scholarship
 - o Your future goals
 - College major/minor
 - o Needs
 - o Extracurricular Activities at school or in the community

All funding decisions will be made by the Foundation with no explanation given if the request is denied. The Foundation does not fund retroactive needs.

Funding by the Throckmorton Foundation is a one-time funding event. If you wish to apply for future awards, please provide the required documentation prior to the beginning of the semester for which you are seeking funds.
