

Alba-Golden Independent School District Translation and Interpretation Procedures

As part of Title I, Part A schoolwide program requirements, Alba-Golden ISD adheres to the following procedures for translation and interpretation services for families of Alba-Golden ISD students.

Families of Alba-Golden ISD students speak two different home languages (English and Spanish) as determined by original home language surveys collected when a student first enrolls in a Texas public school.

- The district has personnel available to translate or interpret as needed for parents or families that speak Spanish as a first language.
- Translation and interpretation services in Spanish will be made available for district and campus level parent events and meetings as needed.
- Translation and interpretation services are available for parent conferences, Language Proficiency Assessment Committee (LPAC) meetings, and Assessment, Review, and Dismissal (ARD) meetings as needed.
- All paper based parent notices, invitations, notes, reports, phone communication and app notices to families originating from the district and campus level will be distributed in English and Spanish as needed.
- The Alba-Golden ISD Parent and Family Engagement Plan will be available in English and Spanish on the district website. Hard copies will be available at the Alba-Golden ISD Central Administration building upon request.
- The Alba-Golden ISD District and Campus Improvement Plans will be available in English and Spanish on the district website. Hard copies will be available at the Alba-Golden ISD Central Administration building upon request.
