DANCE:

Beginning Adult Tap - 8 weeks, \$75, Thurs. nights, March 5 – April 30, 6:30-7:30pm

Beginning Adult Tap is a basic class for beginners. It's a fun way to exercise and make music with your feet. Wear comfortable clothing. Tap shoes are not necessary for this beginning class.

Intermediate Adult Tap - 8 weeks, \$75, Thurs. nights, March 5 – April 30, 5:30-6:30 pm

Intermediate Adult Tap is a refresher course for the more experienced tap dancer.

Ballroom Dancing – 8 weeks, \$100 couple, Mon. nights, March 2 – April 27, 6:30-7:30 pm

Learn how to dance and have fun at the same time. Basic dances for couples are introduced and practiced. Learn Swing, Tango, Waltz, Foxtrot and the Cha Cha. Casual attire may be worn.

GENERAL:

Excel Level I – 3 weeks, \$65, Thurs., Feb. 13 –Feb. 27, 12:00-2:00 pm

Microsoft Excel is a powerful spreadsheet software with business and professional applications. Learn the basics of entering text, numbers, formulas and functions. Learn to format cells, merge and center, add borders, edit, name worksheet tabs, save and print workbooks and create a chart from worksheet data.

Excel Level II – 3 weeks, \$65, Thurs. March 5 – March 19, 12:00-2:00 pm

Learn complex functions and formulas, sort and filter data, and work with multiple worksheets simultaneously.

Word I – 3 weeks, \$65.00, Thurs. April 2 – April 16, 12:00-2:00 pm

In this introductory course, students will learn to create basic documents and work with a variety of Word features.

LANGUAGE:

Beginning Spanish – 8 weeks, \$75.00, Thurs. nights, March 5 - April 30, 5:30-7:30 pm

A beginning conversational course that covers introductions, greetings and farewells, alphabet, sounds, articles, adjectives, nouns, numbers, regular present tense, ser and estar. It also covers vocabulary and phrases related to everyday life. Language skills will be developed with an emphasis on speaking. No book required.

Intermediate Spanish – 8 weeks, \$75.00, Mon. nights, March 2 – April 27, 5:30-7:30 pm

This course is a continuation of Beginning Spanish with emphasis on building vocabulary and developing language and conversation skills. No book required.

Beginning Italian – 8 weeks, \$75.00, Mon. nights, March 2 – April 27, 6:00-7:30 pm

This class is a fun, beginning conversational course taught by a native Italian. The instructor also incorporates interesting facts about Italian culture in her language teaching. Optional book purchase: Barron's "Learn Italian the Fast and Fun Way."
