

Writing Class

4 th Grade: We are making the final touches to our text dependent analysis essays. Students are really learning the balance between citing evidence and explaining what that evidence means.

5 th Grade: In 5 th grade, we are reviewing a variety of writing concepts: writing with clarity, precise word choice, and eliminating run-on sentences.

6 th Grade: The 6 th graders have built their persuasive arguments with solid reasoning, but we've added in the element of fact/research-based reasoning. Students have learned to improve their persuasive power by citing evidence to support their claims. They have some interesting perspectives to share.





6th Science- Working on Science Fair Projects-They have picked their topics and questions. They are working on their hypothesis and should start conducting their experiments.





- Algebraic Thinking solution, range, inequality, distributive, equation
- Base Ten Operations regroup, place value, rounding, estimation, multiplier, difference
- Measurement & Data centimeter, length, kilometer, perimeter
- Geometry perpendicular, reflection, congruent, degrees, coordinates, line segment, prism, solid figure, congruent, translation, parallelogram

Try to use some of these words in conversation at home. Examples:

- -How fast can you run around the perimeter of the house?
