

## PATRIOTIC AND NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Representatives of Patriotic and National Organizations listed in Title 36 of the United States Code, as of July 1, 2018, shall be allowed to speak to students during regular school hours during the first quarter of each academic school year. The Patriotic and National Organization shall provide the school principal with verbal or written notice of the organization's desire to speak to the students to inform the students about the civic involvement of the organization, and to explain how students may participate in or join the patriotic organization. The school principal has discretion over the time, place, and manner when representatives of the organization are allowed to speak to students.

Examples of Patriotic and National Organizations include, but are not limited to:

- American Legion
- Boys Scouts of America
- Boys and Girls Club of America
- Future Farmers of America
- Girl Scouts of the United States of America
- Paralyzed Veterans of America
- Veterans of Foreign Wars of America
