SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT (SLA)

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 1st day of May, 2020 by and between FIVE-STAR TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS, an Indiana limited liability company with a principal address of 8757 Old State Road 60, Sellersburg, Indiana 47172 (the "Company") and Plainfield Community School Corporation, whose address is 985 S. Longfellow Ln, Plainfield, IN 46168 (the "Customer").

Agreements

In consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in this Agreement, Customer and Company hereby agree as follows:

1. Scope of Services.

Company shall, during the Term (as defined below) provide to Customer the following computer and information technology support and consulting services described below (the "Services" or "Work Product") for the "System" as outlined in the Managed Technology Solution proposal and Exhibit B, Specifications, at such times as Customer may reasonably request.

Services include, but are not limited to:

- a) Facilitate and/or assist with installation of patches, fixes, and updates to infrastructure systems and/or servers by request of Customer according to best practices and based on recommendations of the manufacturer or licensor.
- b) Provide remote technical assistance to onsite technical staff, and offer general advice, guidance and recommendations concerning the System.
- c) Evaluate and make recommendations to Customer regarding configurations involving network and server infrastructure, information security, or any other concerns Company may have with the System.
- d) Provide technical consultation for any new projects or tasks Customer requests of Company including, but not limited to, the System.
- e) Maintain a history log or other record for Customer concerning all installations, upgrades, patches, or other Services performed for Customer.
- f) Provide recommendation of backup solution and strategy for deployment and maintenance of aforementioned solution.
- g) Liaise with third party vendors, or other Services or entities, related to the maintenance and upkeep of the System at Customer's request.
- h) Provide consultation, as needed, with Customer in order to schedule any projects, set priorities, or discuss special needs Customer may have involving the System.

Company shall not be responsible for the following:

- a) Items not defined as part of the System.
- b) Providing custom programming assistance, or application development.
- c) Fixing errors and omissions contained in any third-party resource outside of the direct control of Company.
- Routine maintenance, including software updates, of the System unless requested by Customer.
- e) Monitoring of the System, unless requested by Customer.
- f) Telephone system support. Telephone system support, where applicable by Company, shall be covered under a separate agreement.
- g) Providing technical support or assistance during the following nationally recognized federal holidays – New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas.

2. Specifications.

Company agrees to perform the Services using proficient personnel, in a professional and workmanlike manner, according to industry standards, by following manufacturer instructions, in compliance with license agreements, and pursuant to the Specifications set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto (the "Specifications").

3. Term of Service.

This Agreement shall commence on May 1, 2020 and shall continue in full force and in effect until May 1, 2021. After May 1, 2021, this Agreement may be terminated by either party upon at least thirty (30) days prior written notice. Absent a termination notice, no event (except an uncured breach of this Agreement for 30 days after written notice) may terminate this Agreement prior to May 1, 2021. Upon termination of this Agreement, Company shall transfer and make available to Customer all data, records, information, property, and materials in Company's possession or subject to Company's control that are the property of Customer. Company shall make every reasonable effort to secure all written or descriptive matter that pertains to the Services or Work Product and agrees to provide reasonable cooperation to arrange for the transfer of all Customer data, records, information, property, contracts, agreements, supplies, and other third-party interests, including those not then utilized, and all rights and claims thereto and therein. In the event of loss or destruction of any such material or descriptive matter, Company shall immediately notify Customer of the details of the loss or destruction in writing and provide the necessary information for a loss statement or other documentation to Customer.

Customer agrees to inform Company of any modification, installation, or service performed on the network by individuals not employed by Company in order to assist Company in providing an efficient network support response.

4. Ownership Rights.

Company shall have ownership to all Company Material. "Company Material" consists of all copyrightable:

- (a) Materials that do not constitute Services or Work Product (as defined in Section 1, Scope of Services, and in Exhibit B, Specifications)
- (b) Materials that are solely owned by Company ("Pre-existing Works") or licensed to Company.
- (c) Materials owned or licensed by Company that are incorporated into the Work Product or a part of the Services.

Company shall hold and represents and warrant it holds all rights, title, and interest in and to Company Material. Customer shall follow Company's instructions and not do anything that may infringe upon or in any way undermine Company rights, title, and interest in Company Material, as described in this paragraph 4. Notwithstanding the above, Company hereby grants Customer an unrestricted, nonexclusive, perpetual, fully paid-up, worldwide license for the use or for the sublicense of the use of any Company Material and Work Product used, created, or maintained under this Agreement.

5. Employee Non-Solicitation

During the term of this Agreement, and for a period of one (1) year thereafter, Customer and Company shall not, directly or indirectly, for itself or any third party, solicit or offer employment to, or hire any employee, or former employee of the other party. The terms "former employee" shall include only those employees of Company or Customer who were employed or utilized by Company or Customer on the effective date of this agreement.

6. Compensation.

For all Services received under this Agreement, Customer shall compensate Company, pursuant to the terms of Exhibit A attached hereto. In the event Customer fails to make any of the payments referenced in Exhibit A by the deadline set forth in Exhibit A, Company has the right, but is not obligated, to pursue any or all of the following remedies following thirty (30) days written notice: (1) terminate the Agreement (breach), (2) immediately stop all Services, or (3) bring legal action.

7. Work Performed at Customer's Location.

Rules governing work performed by the Company that is considered "onsite" shall be defined in Exhibit B. Rules shall include, but are not limited to: availability of Company for visits, any required number of onsite visits for this agreement, defining provisions and responsibilities for Customer to accommodate onsite visits and any other related matters pertaining to work performed at Customer's location or locations.

8. Mutual Confidentiality.

Customer and Company acknowledge and agree that the Specifications and all other documents and information related to the performance, production, creation or any expression of the Services or Work Product are the property of Customer. Materials shared between Company and Customer (the "Confidential Information") including, but not limited to, protected health information ("PHI"), nonpublic personal information ("NPI"), personally identifiable information ("PII"), student education records, nonpublic documentation, product specifications, drawings, pictures, photographs, charts, correspondence, supplier lists, financial reports, analyses and other furnished property shall be the exclusive property of the respective owner (the "Owning Party") and will constitute valuable trade secrets. Both parties shall keep the Confidential Information in confidence, protected, secure, and shall not, at any time during or after the term of this Agreement, without prior written consent from the Owning Party or as required by Indiana Public Access laws, disclose or otherwise make available to

anyone, either directly or indirectly, all or any part of the Confidential Information. Excluded from the "Confidential Information" definition is anything that is in the public domain, can be seen by the public, or has been previously made available by the Owning Party in a public venue or is a public record subject to disclosure under Indiana Public Access laws.

9. Limited Warranty and Limitation on Damages.

Company warrants the Services or Work Product(s) will conform to the Specifications set forth in Exhibit B. If the Services or Work Product do not conform to the Specifications, Company shall be responsible for promptly correcting the Services or Work Product without unreasonable delay, at Company sole expense and without charge to Customer, to bring the Services or Work Product into conformance with the Specifications. This warranty shall be the exclusive warranty available to Customer when the Services or Work Products do not conform to the Specifications. Unless outlined in this Agreement, the Materials, or documentation published by Company to all customers, Company disclaims any other warranty, express or implied. Customer acknowledges that Company is not responsible for the results obtained by Customer when using any Services or Work Product produced by Company. Customer and Company waive any claim for punitive damages and agrees that the limit for damages (either in contract or tort) is the greater of 1) the amount of insurance proceeds payable or the consideration owed to Company as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto. No action, regardless of form, arising out of the Services rendered or Work Product, under the Agreement, may be brought by either party more than two (2) years after the later of 1) the cause of action has occurred or 2) termination of this Agreement. In no event shall either party be held liable for consequential damages.

10. Independent Contractor.

Company is retained as an independent contractor. This Agreement is not exclusive. No part of this Agreement shall be construed to represent the creation of an employment, agency, partnership, affiliation, association, or joint venture agreement between the parties. Company will be fully responsible for payment of its own taxes on all compensation earned under this Agreement. Company will withhold and pay any income tax, social security tax, or any other payroll taxes required of it by the IRS and Indiana Department of Revenue. Company understands that it and its employees will not be entitled to any insurance or benefits that Customer provides for Customer's employees generally or to any statutory employment benefits, including without limitation worker's compensation or unemployment insurance.

10.1 Independent Contractor Behavior.

Company agrees to adhere to all of Customer's policies and procedures concerning code and conduct while on Customer's premises. Customer agrees to make available to Company prior to the commencement of this Agreement all manuals, codes, rules, and regulations that Customer requires Customer's staff or employees to read and/or sign including but not limited to rules and guidelines located at http://policies.plainfield.k12.in.us/ Company hereby covenants and agrees to conduct adequate background checks and make a good faith effort to provide and maintain a drug-free workplace. Company shall execute its responsibilities by following and applying at all times the highest professional, industry, and technical guidelines and standards. If Customer becomes dissatisfied with the work product of or the working relationship with those individuals assigned to work on this Agreement, Customer may request in writing the replacement of any or all such individuals, and Company shall grant such request.

11. Insurance.

Company shall maintain throughout the entire term of this Agreement, adequate insurance providing coverage against liability for bodily injury, death, and property damage that may arise out of or be based upon any act or omission of Company or any of its employees, agents, or subcontractors under this Agreement. Upon written request, Company shall provide certificates from their insurers indicating the amount of insurance coverage, the nature of such coverage, and the expiration date of each applicable policy. Company shall not name Customer as an additional insured on any applicable policy at any time during this Agreement, or as a condition of acceptance of this Agreement. Company and any subcontractors shall secure and keep in force during the term of this Agreement the following insurance coverages covering Company for any and all claims of any nature which may in any manner arise out of or result from Company's performance under this Agreement:

- 1. Commercial general liability, including contractual coverage, and products or completed operations coverage, with minimum liability limits not less than \$700,000 per person and \$5,000,000 per occurrence.
- 2. Automobile liability for owned, non-owned and hired autos with minimum liability limits not less than \$700,000 per person and \$5,000,000 per occurrence.
- 3. Errors and Omissions liability with minimum liability limits of \$1,000,000 per claim and in the aggregate. Coverage for the benefit of Customer shall continue for a period of two (2) years after the date of service provided under this Agreement.
- 4. Cyber Liability addressing risks associated with electronic transmissions, the internet, networks and informational assets, and having limits of no less than \$700,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 in the aggregate.

Company may purchase and use an umbrella policy to increase coverages to the above limits.

12. Equipment.

Customer agrees to ensure that the System will be housed and operated in its existing climate-controlled room which maintains an air temperature ranging between 45°F and 75°F, with relative humidity not exceeding 80% non-condensing. Furthermore, Customer agrees to provide the existing three-foot minimum clearance in front of equipment, dedicated power source of 117 volts A.C. 20 amp circuit with a ground, and the System will be protected at all times by UPS power conditioning. If the Authorized Location fails to meet these specifications in the future, or if the System is moved from the indicated location without written notice given to Company, subject to the terms and conditions as may be established by Company, then Company shall have the right to terminate this Agreement following thirty (30) day opportunity to cure without any liability to Company.

13 Expenses.

Company will not be reimbursed for any travel, accommodations, costs, and expenses incurred in connection with the Services or Work Product, whether direct or indirect, without the express written request and approval of Customer.

14. General Provisions.

14.1 Modification of Agreement.

14.12 No responsibility for loss.

Unless caused by its negligence or misconduct, Company is not responsible for any down time; lost, damaged, or destroyed software program data or other information stored or residing on any media or any part of the System; as well as any damage resulting from activities considered beyond the control of Company such as war, riots, natural disasters, vandalism, Customer negligence, equipment failures, acts of nature, and theft.

14.13 Mediation.

If any dispute in relation to this Agreement between Company and Customer is not resolved through informal discussion, within thirty (30) days from the date of dispute the parties agree to submit the issue first before a mediator and then a court in the event that mediation fails or is not commenced within thirty (30) days of a request for mediation. G-19 PROFESSIONAL STAFF LEAVES AND ABSENCES

A teacher who has been employed by the school corporation for at least one year and who has worked at least 1,250 hours during the previous 12 months may find it necessary to take a leave of absence from work for certain family or medical reasons as provided in the Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 (29 U.S.C. ' 2001 et seq.). The school corporation will grant such a teacher up to 12 weeks of unpaid, job-protected leave per year for the birth of a child or the placement of a child with the teacher for adoption or foster care, for the teacher's own serious illness, or for the serious illness of the teacher's spouse, parent, or child. During a teacher's family or medical leave, the school corporation will continue to pay its share of the cost of the teacher's health care coverage.

An employee may find it necessary to take a leave of absence from work for certain family or medical reasons. The school corporation will grant such an employee up to 12 weeks of unpaid leave per year per a physician's substantiation for:

- the birth of a child, or placement of a child with the employee for adoption or foster care;
- the employee's own serious health condition;
- because the employee is needed to care for the employee's spouse, child, or parent due to his/her serious health condition.

During an employee's family or medical leave, the school corporation will continue to pay its share of the cost of the employee's health insurance coverage, if applicable.
