

**Barneveld School District
Legal Status**

The Barneveld School Board is an elected, legally constituted body of the State of Wisconsin responsible for providing a school program and establishing general policies in keeping with the requirements of state and federal laws.

The school board is organized and operates under Wisconsin Statutes and under its own adopted policies. As per a local decision made and voted upon at the Annual Meeting, July 25, 1988, the Barneveld School Board shall consist of seven (7) members.

The purpose of the school board, according to Wisconsin State Laws, is to provide the highest quality educational programs for the residents of the District in which the board operates. The Barneveld School Board will take into account the wishes of the people of the District and their ability and willingness to support such educational programs.

A fundamental objective of school board policy is the administration of educational programs. Written policies provide staff with assurances they are performing in accordance with the purpose of the School District. The school board believes that policy making is a continuing process.
