WHEREAS, written notice of intent to expel a student was served upon the student and the student's parents, the School Board has reviewed the written notice of intent to expel, and the stated factual basis for expulsion was explained in the notice of intent to expel the student;

WHEREAS, notice of intent to expel the student complied with the provisions of the Pupil Fair Dismissal Act, Minn. Stat. § 121A.47, subd. 2;

WHEREAS, the student and the student's parent waived their right to a hearing on the proposed expulsion in writing; and

WHEREAS, under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, the waiver of right to an expulsion hearing and the name of the student proposed for expulsion are private data.

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED. AS FOLLOWS:
