**In the event of unexpected schedule changes due to snow delays, field trips, conflict of schedules, or any other unforeseen issues, transportation will follow the St. Mary's High School transportation schedule. As in the past, we will do everything we can to accommodate all schools.**

**Communication/Absences/Student Conduct/Grievance:**

If school or transportation is canceled for any reason, families will receive a phone call, text or email prior to the scheduled pick up. If a student is not going to ride for any reason, parents are asked to directly contact the driver.
