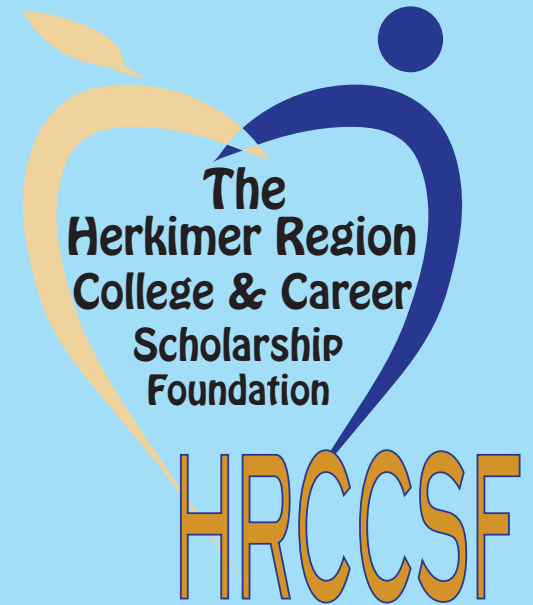

# What Is The Herkimer Region College and Career Scholarship Foundation?

Herkimer Region College and Career Scholarship Foundation is a volunteer-operated community scholarship foundation. HRCCSF is a group of local citizens from many professions who are working voluntarily to raise scholarship money for graduates of Herkimer BOCES Service Area Career and Technical Programs. Students are eligible by graduating with an approved sequence (major) in vocational education from one of the following school districts: Central Valley, Dolgeville, Frankfort-Schuyler, Herkimer, Little Falls, Mount Markham, Owen D. Young, Poland, Richfield Springs, and West Canada Valley. Adults who wish to enter Herkimer BOCES Career and Technical programs are also eligible. It is an organization working with the approval and encouragement of the Herkimer BOCES, however, scholarships are not administered by BOCES.

HRCCSF is comprised of individuals who believe in the potential of our local people. Their efforts, with the support of the community, demonstrate that Herkimer and surrounding counties really care about education.

It is important to note that because HRCCSF is a volunteer organization, none of the money raised is used for administrative costs. All dollars raised in our community are awarded to local students.

# How Does The HRCCSF Help Students?

## DOES THE HERKIMER REGION COLLEGE AND CAREER SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION CONFLICT WITH OTHER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS?

No, HRCCSF does not compete with any existing programs. Rather, it seeks to expand the numbers and amounts of awards this community can provide to post-secondary students and adults. The foundation may also act as an umbrella for the administration of many scholarships when an agreement is reached between an existing scholarship and HRCCSF. Thus, students may be required to make just one application to be considered for many awards.

## How may I apply for a scholarship?

Applications are available from guidance counselors at all ten component school districts and Herkimer BOCES.

As costs for further education continue to escalate and Federal aid decreases, the need for more community scholarships is great. The Herkimer Region College and Career Scholarship Foundation is the best response to this need, providing:

- A planned approach for increasing local scholarships.
- A place for charitable gifts that assist local students.
- A system for recognizing and rewarding a wide range of deserving students.
