The School Safety Drill Act was amended this school year requiring school districts to develop threat assessment protocols and threat assessment teams. The intent of the new requirement is to ensure that procedures are in place by school districts to adequately document threats towards others and threat of self-harm in a manner consistent with other public schools.
