

NAEP TESTING for selected students Tuesday, April 21st

We are excited to announce that HHS has been selected to participate in the 2019–2020 National Assessment of Educational Progress, also known as NAEP. It is the largest continuing and nationally representative assessment of what students across the country know and can do in a variety of subjects. Some of our seventeen-year-olds have been selected to take a 90 minute assessment in math or reading. Students who have been selected for the NAEP Test will be notified in the coming weeks. Selected students can use the test session towards community service hours and also list the experience on their resume. Additional details will follow as we move closer to assessment day. From Ms. Amy Boscolo, Assistant Principal/Athletic Director: Winter Sports Update-

The dance team finished 9th at the IHSA State Tournament this season performing their lyrical dance. They also finished 2nd at the IDTA State Tournament performing their jazz dance. The ladies complete their season on Feb. 25 at HHS with the boys basketball game.

Cheerleading finished 12th at the IHSA State Tournament. The ladies will perform for the last time at home on February 25 at HHS during the boys basketball game.

Wrestling had 3 athletes qualify for the IHSA Sectional Tournament. Alex Reed, Tanner Schrantz, and Ben Mitchell did not move on to the IHSA State Tournament, but ended their season with tough matches at Mascoutah.

Boys Bowling was represented at the IHSA State Bowling Tournament by Austin Davis. This was the first State qualifier for the boys since Brandon Munie in 2018.

Girls Bowling has qualified for the State Tournament as a team! This is the first time in HHS history that we are sending an entire girls bowling team to State. Molly Marshall finished 2nd and Carissa Merkel finished 10th overall at Sectionals. The last State qualifier for the girls program was Emma Schuster in 2018.



Boys Basketball will celebrate Senior night on Tuesday, February 25, 2020 taking on Civic Memorial. We will honor all senior dancers, cheerleaders, and boys basketball players during this game. Boys basketball held a Law Enforcement Appreciation night against Waterloo on February 14. We were honored to have State Trooper Nicholas Hopkins' family join us for this event. With the help of students, staff, parents, and community members, over \$2,200 was raised in memory of Trooper Hopkins and will be donated to the Illinois State Police Heritage Fund.

Regionals for girls basketball takes place on February 18 and February 20. With victories, the ladies will move onto Sectionals the week of February 24th.

From the School Counselors-Mary Jackson (Department Chair), Carrie Lieberman, and Amber Spaeth:

January was a busy month with pre-registration for the 2020-2021 School Year. We had 581 students sign in for counselor visits. Visits included 13% seniors, 9% juniors, 40% sophomores and 38% freshman. Visits included 79% of those students coming in regarding academic reasons, 9% for college or career reasons, and 12% visiting for personal reasons. Counselors also spent time at HMS administering *Interest Inventories* to the 8th grade students before our parent night. This proved beneficial when families attended parent night and presented meaningful questions about our



college, career, and tech ed offerings. We also saw increased engagement during the registration presentations with those students. We had a successful 8th grade parent night with a packed house. We also appreciate HHS teachers being available in the evening to answer questions and ease the anxiety of the families as well. SWIC was back to enroll semester 2 students in dual credit courses. SAT SUITE OF ASSESSMENTS

Participation in College Planning Options Consent Form

Your child will participate in one of the SAT* Suite of Assessments on a school day—SAT', PSAT/NMSQT* or the PSAT™ 10. The purpose of this form is to explain the information your student will be required to provide and the options available to your student related to their free SAT score sends, Student Search Service*, and the student questionnaire.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

Students will be required to provide College Board, the provider of the SAT Suite of Assessments, their first and last name, school name and school code, date of birth, grade level, gender and, for some states and districts, student identification number. This information is the minimum needed for scoring and reporting test results.

Options for Students

FREE SCORE SENDS

Students who are taking the SAT can send their scores to up to four colleges or scholarship programs at no cost. Score sends are optional, but we encourage students to demonstrate their interest in their chosen schools early. If left blank, no scores will be sent. Consent is not required for students to utilize their four free score sends.

STUDENT SEARCH SERVICE

As a parent, you can give consent for your student to opt in to Student Search Service when they complete their answer sheet. Student Search Service connects students with colleges and scholarship organizations by sharing their information with participating organizations. This offers you and your student:

- Information about colleges and universities that match your student's academic interests
- Information on financial aid and scholarships to help deserving students access scholarships they've earned
- Information about majors, courses, and degree options

College Board only shares student data with eligible colleges, universities, scholarships, and educational opportunity programs that have signed an agreement to only communicate with students for the purposes listed above. These entities most often connect with students based on expected graduation date, cumulative grade point average (GPA), score range, and intended college major.

STUDENT QUESTIONNAIRE

As a parent, you can give consent for your student to participate in the student questionnaire. The information from these questions will be added to their College Board student record. Your child's responses to the optional questionnaire:

- Provide data used by College Board for research and planning to improve tests and services
- Help match students with colleges, universities, scholarships, and educational opportunity programs

The Student Guide describes what the questionnaire asks and how student information is used. Please review the Student Guide and indicate below if your child will or will not complete the optional questionnaire and opt in to Student Search Service.
