## District 1:1 Device Protection Plan

The Elkhorn Valley Public School District recognizes that with the implementation of the 1:1 Device initiative there is a need to protect the investment both by the District and the Student/Parent. The following outlines the various areas of protection: warranty, accidental damage protection and insurance.

### School District Protection

School District Protection is available for students and parents to cover 1:1 Device replacement in the event of theft, loss, or accidental damage. The protection cost is \$50.00 annually for each Device with a maximum cost of \$150.00 per family per year. This plan will include one repair or replacement of the Device (not including peripherals, i.e power adapter and/or apple pencil); additional repairs or replacements will be the full responsibility of the student. Parents will need to purchase this insurance from Elkhorn Valley Schools before your student is allowed to check out a 1:1 Device.

### Personal Home or Homeowners Coverage

Students or parents may wish to carry their own personal insurance to protect the Device in cases of theft, loss, or accidental damage. Please consult with your insurance agent for details about your personal coverage of the Device..

Additional Information: In cases of theft, vandalism and other criminal acts, a police report, or in the case of a fire, a report MUST be filed by the student or parent for the protection coverage to take place. A copy of the police/fire report must be provided to the principal's office. **INTENTIONAL DAMAGE:** Students/Parents are responsible for full payment of intentional damages to Device. Warranty, Accidental Damage Protection, or School District 1:1 Device Protection DOES NOT cover intentional damage of the Device..

### Student Pledge for 1:1 Device Use

1. I will take good care of my 1:1 Device.
2. I will never leave the Device unattended. (exception- permission to charge battery at a school approved charging station)
3. I will never loan out my Device to other individuals.
4. I will know where my Device is at all times.
5. I will charge my Device battery as needed.
6. I will keep food and beverages away from my Device since they may cause damage to the Device.
7. I will not disassemble any part of my Device or attempt any repairs.
8. I will protect my Device by only carrying it while in the case provided.
9. I will use my Device in ways that are appropriate, meet Elkhorn Valley Public School District expectations, and are educational.
10. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the Device or provided case; I will not deface any sticker applied to any Device applied by Elkhorn Valley Public School.
11. I understand that my Device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains property of the Elkhorn Valley Public School District.
12. I will follow the policies outlined in the 1:1 Device Handbook and the Use of the Acceptable Use Policy while at school, as well as outside the school day.
13. I will file a police report in case of theft or vandalism, as well as report to the Elkhorn Valley Public School District.
14. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse. I will report any damages or loss to the Elkhorn Valley High School office.
15. I agree to return the Device, case and power cords in good working condition.

## **Device Use.**

**Individual school 1:1 Devices and accessories must be returned to the Elkhorn Valley Library at the end of each school year. Students who graduate early, withdraw, are suspended or expelled, or terminate enrollment at Elkhorn Valley Public School District for any other reason must return their individual school 1:1 Device on the date of termination.**

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
