# Fluid Art Pour Paintings

This art form, accidently discovered by David Alfaro Siqueiros in the 1930s, consists of pouring paint onto a canvas and tilting the paint to create a unique design. The different colors of paint, having different densities, will either rise to the top or bottom of the other colors.

The 8<sup>th</sup> graders worked with partners to choose their colors, mix their paint with a pouring medium, and learn the process of pouring the paint onto their canvases. Each group's painting came out successful and will be submitted into the NVC art show in the spring.

# Vaccination Week

This week was established in 2005 to highlight the importance of continuing flu vaccination through the holiday season and beyond. As long as flu viruses are spreading and causing illness, vaccination should continue throughout the flu season in order to protect as many people as possible against flu. Even if you have already gotten sick with the flu, you can still benefit from vaccination since many different flu viruses spread during flu season and most flu vaccine protects against four different flu viruses.

Flu isn't a "bad cold" and can result in serious health complications, such as pneumonia, bacterial infections, and can lead to hospitalization. Flu can sometimes even lead to death. You can catch influenza in the same ways as you can catch a cold. It starts very quickly. As the flu activity in the US is increasing, NOW is the time to get your flu vaccine!

# **Recipes from the Nurse**

## **Biscuits and Gravy Casserole**

1 (16.3 ounce) package refrigerated biscuits

1 pound ground sausage


3 Tablespoons flour

2 1/2 cups milk

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

### **Cooking Instructions:**



### Raspberry Cream Cheese Jello Salad

1 (29 ounce) can sliced pears (reserve 1 cup of the juice)

1 cup water

1 (6 ounce) box raspberry jello

1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese (softened)

1 (12 ounce) carton Cool Whip (thawed)

1 cup whipped cream - optional topping

1 cup raspberries - optional topping

# **Cooking Instructions:**

Open can of pears and drain 1 cup of the pear juice into a bowl. Set bowl aside and throw away the rest of the juice.\_Add 1 cup of water to pear juice and microwave the liquid for 2-3 minutes or until water is boiling.\_Add box of raspberry jello to the boiling liquid and stir until all jello has dissolved. Set bowl in fridge and allow it to cool for about 7-10 minutes (you don't want the jello to set, you just want it to cool down).\_Dump pears and softened cream cheese into a large blender. Add in cooled jello and container of Cool Whip. Blend until completely combined.\_Pour jello into 9x13" pan and set in the fridge until jello is completely set (should take 3-4 hours - you could also let it set up overnight). Serve topped with whipped cream and fresh raspberries.
