Scholarships



The Credit Union sponsors scholarships to be awarded each year to undergraduate members who are in good standing and are or will be enrolled at Emporia State University.

These scholarships are awarded on an annual (two semester) basis beginning with the fall semester. Conditions eligibility include membership in good standing for a period of no less than one year prior to the term for which the application is submitted.

Interested students can visit our website at esfcu.com, select the Scholarships tab for a fillable application. Completed applications must be returned to the credit union by March 1st. The awards will be made for the following fall and spring semesters.



To be considered for the Flint Hills Technical College scholarship, candidates must meet and maintain the following criteria:

- Must have a minimum high school or college cumulative 2.75 GPA
- Student enrolling for the first time or a student who has completed a technical certificate at FHTC and pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree.
- Must be a post-secondary degree-seeking student enrolling in the fall semester. Priority will be given to full-time enrollment. Part-time enrollment considered.
- Completion of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). However, financial need will not be the determining factor in awarding this scholarship.

Students must complete the scholarship application process at Flint Hills Technical College. Applications will be reviewed and awarded according to the established criteria and the FHTC Scholarship Committee procedures.



In addition, Emporia State Federal Credit Union has established an annual \$500 scholarship for one Emporia High School graduating senior. This scholarship may be used towards any accredited university or technical college. Please contact a counselor at Emporia High School for details.
