## Fifth Grade Math Vocabulary Terms

- Algebraic Thinking - order of operations, coefficient, braces, parentheses, brackets
- Base Ten Operations - dividend, multiplicand, subtrahend, quotient
- Fractions - reduce, divisible, ratio, greatest common factor
- Measurement \& Data - square unit, x \& y- axis, increments, probability, median, mode, stem and leaf plot
- Geometry - diagonal, translation, reflection, transformation, tessellation, quadrilateral
