## **2023 Summer School Program**

Welcome to the 2023 Summer School Program at Coolidge Elementary School! We are excited to begin this year's program and look forward to the engaging learning activities for all students. All summer school classes are free of charge this year. Students who attend Summer School will participate in various Reading and Math activities; as well as Art, Health/PE and Social Emotional Learning. Students who are attending one of our Enrichment Summer School programs will attend Summer School during the same dates, times, and location. To ensure students are successful, we ask that students are dropped off and picked up in a prompt manner. Students that are not picked up within fifteen minutes of Summer School ending will be disenrolled from the program after the second time.

A few expectations of attending Summer School are:

- 1. Be prompt and prepared to work
- 2. Be respectful of the teacher and other students
- 3. Work hard and give your best effort

Please review the information below regarding arrival and dismissal, as well as some general information about summer school.

### **General Information**

- Summer School classes are held at Coolidge Elementary School (17845 Henry Street) from 8:15 am 12:45 pm on the following dates: June 20th July 20th (Monday Thursday) Summer School will NOT be in session on Monday, June 19th in observation of Juneteenth, as well as Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> in observation of Independence Day.
- Being respectful, responsible, and safe is expected of all students. Parents/guardians will be notified if there are any disciplinary issues and may be required to pick up their child. Depending on the severity of the disciplinary issue, your child may be disenrolled from their program.
- Bus transportation is available for summer school students at the stops listed below.
- Fifth-grade students will attend summer school at Memorial Junior High School unless they are attending one of the Elementary Summer School Enrichment Programs (Time Travelers or Intramurals).

# **Breakfast/Snacks**

- Breakfast will be offered to the students attending summer school at no cost. Breakfast will be available from 8:15 am 8:30 am. The students will eat in the Multipurpose Room at Coolidge.
- Students are encouraged to bring a healthy snack (fruit, carrots, pretzels, crackers, etc.) and a water bottle to summer school. There are water bottle fillers at most of the drinking fountains at Coolidge.

### **Dress Code**

- Students should wear appropriate shoes/clothing for recess activities. Flip-flops will not be permitted. The regular school year dress code applies to summer school as well.
- To ensure an effective learning environment is maintained, students are not permitted to bring toys, cards, hand-held video games/electronics or other non-instructional items to summer school.
- Students will participate in motor breaks outside, weather permitting.

### **Arrival Information**

- Students will enter Coolidge through Door 1 at the main entrance and will either walk to the Multipurpose Room or their arrival location. No student should arrive prior to 8:15 am.
- Breakfast will be offered to the students attending Summer School at no cost. Breakfast will be served from 8:15 am 8:30 am in the Multipurpose Room.
- Henry Street will remain a one-way street heading north towards 178th Street.
- Adams Street will remain a one-way street heading west towards Henry Street.
- William Street will remain a one-way street heading south towards Adams Street.
- The Horseshoe Drive will be open for quick drop-off. Remember to drive carefully and keep the traffic moving. Please be cautious as students will be exiting the cars.

### **Dismissal Information**

- Summer school dismissal is at 12:45pm.
- Students in Pre-Kindergarten & Kindergarten will be dismissed from Door 12 (Adams Street).
- Students in First Grade, Second Grade and Third Grade will dismiss out of Door 11 (178th Street).
- Students in Fourth Grade will dismiss out of Door 9 (William Street). The parking lot along William Street will be closed during dismissal.
- Henry Street will remain a one-way street heading north towards 178th Street.
- Adams Street will remain a one-way street heading west towards Henry Street.
- William Street will remain a one-way street heading south towards Adams Street.
- Students who have not been picked up will be brought to the main office (Door 1) at
- 12:55pm. (Parent/Guardians will need to come inside to sign out their child).

### **Bus Transportation**

Bus service is available at the stops/times listed below if you are interested. If students ride the bus to Summer School in the morning, they will be riding the bus home in the afternoon unless the office is called or a note from a guardian is received. Bus students will exit the building out of Door 8 to board their bus. Bus routes will run in reverse order during dismissal, ending at Reavis and Oak Glen. The times listed below may be off by a few minutes for the first few days of summer school. We want to make sure all students are safe and accounted for.
