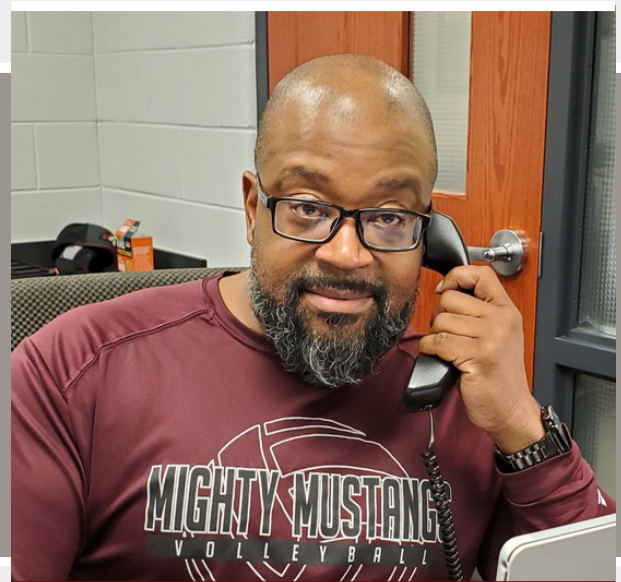

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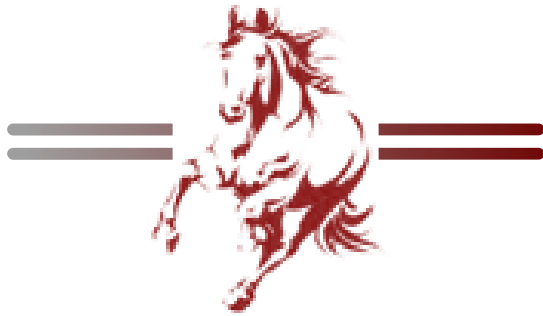

We want to empower our families by connecting them to important information about their child and their learning. District158 uses a secure, web-based system called PowerSchool which parents/guardians can access through its Parent Portal.

This system contains real-time access to student information provided at the time of registration and also has student schedules, attendance information, student grades and assignments, health information and more! Student report cards and progress reports are also available via PowerSchool.

All parents/guardians must create and register their PowerSchool Parent Portal account in order to have access.



AT MJHS we have a staggered dismissal at the end of the day. This is to reduce car and foot traffic and to increase safety for all students and their parents. 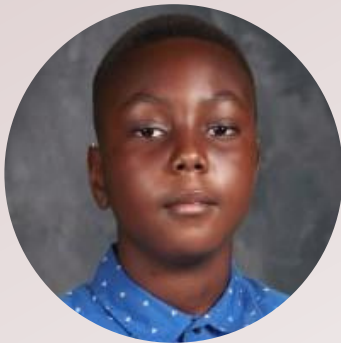

Our Mustangs of the Month receive a personalized certificate, their name read on the morning announcements, their name in the 7th-grade newsletter, and positive call home.

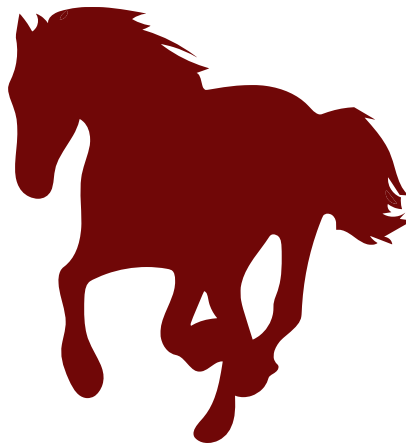
