

2020 OHS Drivers Education Information

Welcome to the OHS Drivers Education Course. Our goal is to help beginning drivers prepare for their role in the Highway Transportation System. Parents have a vital role towards the successful completion of the course by the student.

Guidelines to successfully complete the course:

1. MUST be 14 years old or having their 14th birthday no later than Tuesday, May 26th, 2020.
2. ATTEND all scheduled classroom and driving sessions.
3. BEHAVE in a manner that allows learning to take place in a safe environment.
4. COMPLETE all of the requirements in the classroom phase and behind-the-wheel phase of the course.
5. ABIDE by all driving laws.

Course Fee = \$150.00 for USD290 Students, or \$275.00 for out of district or homeschooled students.

Enrollment

Students may enroll online or in person according to the following schedule. **All students without an Instruction Permit must attend the session for their grade level to complete the required eye screening test so please bring *glasses or contacts* if you need them.**

IMPORTANT: Please consider family vacations, summer sports camps, dance camps, morning weight training and conditioning, work schedules and anything else that might interfere with your classroom and driving before picking times. Students are expected to not miss classroom or driving times once they are enrolled.

- **STEP 2:** Select a driving session with either Mr. Laws or Mr. Shaffer during the respective event. If you choose to drive during the classroom dates, choose a driving session around your class time.(example: Class time at 8:00 am -10:00 am; Drive session at 7:00 am or after 10:00 am)
- **STEP 3:** Finalize the application during the respective events for a vision exam and student signature as required by Kansas Law.
