

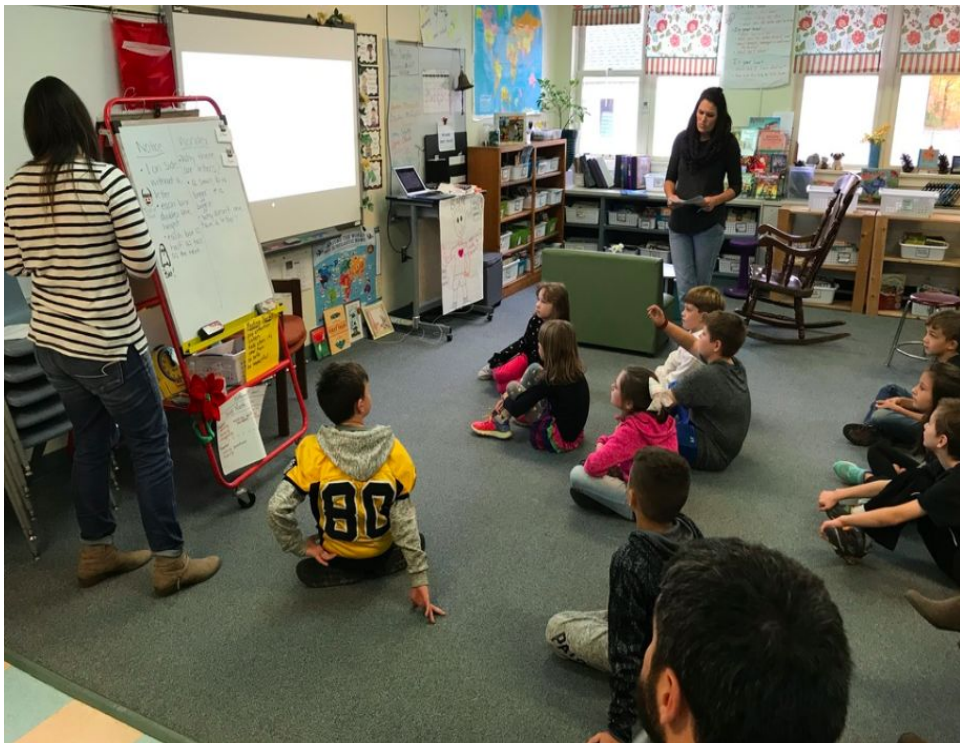

Teacher Feedback

Celebrations:

“ALL kids doing the math, kids solving problems using a variety of mathematical strategies”

“Consistent language in the units, the teacher narrative is helpful”

Challenges:

“Differentiation still poses a challenge, but we know it's coming”

“synthesis, incorporating it when the class conversation goes in a different direction than anticipated. Finding time to incorporate centers”

Analyzing Teacher Feedback

“Summary: teachers are still struggling with pacing of the lesson across the math block which is impacting pacing across the units. We need to find more time to plan together so that we can identify the parts of the lessons that need more time, and the parts of the lessons that can be moved through more quickly.”
