**REPORTS:**

ACIS reported that they have identified most of the network connections. The wireless connection has a large usage issue. They are looking into some changes for wireless. The district has 63 teacher-staff machines in the district. The backup system will need to be addressed and the fiber optic system also. ACIS is doing a great job for the district with only just starting.

Mr. Preston presented for transportation. Bus inspections were last week and the fleet passed all 9 buses with no issues. Routes are running smooth. The buses have several miles on them.

Mr. Burton and Mr. Gandy presented with JH-HS history. Mr. Burton is currently teaching Civil War in 8<sup>th</sup> grade and Industrial Revolution in 7<sup>th</sup>. Each student is expected to participate in class. Students are given assignments and quizzes. Students keep notebooks for class and are expected to be graded on there notes for a grade.

Mr. Gandy is the new HS history teacher this year. His core classes are directed to the MO standards. Goals for students are to be a good citizen, use the skills provided with teaching, and relate to current events of past, present, future, and your life. Mr. Gandy uses the portfolio system in class. He teaches World history, American history, American government, and current events.

Mrs. Burton, Mrs. Morrison, and Mr. Teel presented for the English dept. Mrs. Burton is the JH level for the district. Students read, discuss, interpret, and analyze all aspects of informational text and all genres of literature. Students have grammar, writing, novels to read, and test preparations to learn. Mrs. Morrison and Mr. Teel are HS level English. Mrs. Morrison has English I, III, IV, Graphic novel, and contemporary literature classes. She makes lessons rigorous and engaging by incorporating movement, collaborative learning, critical thinking, and analytical discussion into weekly lessons. Mr. Teel teaches English II, College prep I and II. Classes are taught at a high learning level for the students interested in college. Mr. Teel is a professor at the college level also. The college prep classes give students a solid introduction to the skills required to succeed in college classes, including analyzing complex texts, delineating arguments, writing, collaboration, communication, and time management.
