SIUE Engineering Summer Camp is designed to introduce high school freshmen, sophomores, and juniors interested in science and technology to various areas of engineering, computer science, and construction. Campers design and program a video game, build robots, bridges, hovercrafts, and get to see engineering in action.

Campers experience a taste of college life as they stay in the dorms for the week of camp, enjoy meals at the Morris University Center, and build lasting friendships with campers from other schools.



MEALS, HOUSING, AND RECREATION

Campers enjoy the social aspect of living with a roommate in the university residence halls, and each camper receives a university debit card for use at the restaurants, cafeteria, and convenience store. Campers also have access to the university's athletic facilities and Morris University Center in the evenings for a wide range of individual and group activities including bowling, swimming, climbing the rock wall, volleyball, soccer, pool, arcade games, basketball, and many more.

SUPERVISION AND INSURANCE

Participants are supervised during all camp activities, and camp counselors stay overnight in the residence halls. All participants are provided with limited Camper's Medical Benefit Coverage during the program. Coverage will provide for necessary medical treatment of accidental injury up to the policy maximum.

PROGRAM COST

The fee is \$450 and includes housing, food, transportation to and from field trips, as well as necessary materials and supplies. A limited number of scholarships are available for students who can demonstrate financial need.
