



STUDENT SUCCESS ACT

The Student Success Act is a historic opportunity for Oregon schools. When fully implemented our state will see an additional \$1 billion investment in schools each year. This investment provides new opportunities for every student in our state, particularly students who have been historically underserved.

STUDENT INVESTMENT ACCOUNT (SIA)



Making up at least 50% of the Student Success Act, Student Investment Account funds are non-competitive grants available to all school districts and eligible charter schools. The purpose of the funds are to:

1. Meet students' mental and behavioral health needs.
2. Increase academic achievement & reduce academic

disparities for students of color; students with disabilities; emerging bilingual students; and students navigating poverty, homelessness, and foster care; and other student groups that have historically experienced academic disparities.

The law requires school districts to meaningfully engage stakeholders to determine the best investments for students in their local community while explicitly focusing on student mental and behavior health, addressing disparities based on race or disability, and improving teaching and learning conditions. The law is rooted in equity, authentic community engagement and shared accountability for student success.

Where are applicants in the process?

All applicants are working on SIA PLAN DEVELOPMENT for submission to ODE March 2 – April 15, 2020. SIA applications require the following process:
