SUBJECT: FEES FOR THE USE OF SCHOOL BUSES

Having established that the cost per mile for operating a school bus for student transportation is approximately sixty-two cents (62¢) per mile exclusive of driver and fuel and having established that in addition to the cost "other purpose miles" as identified by the New York State Department of Education are non-aidable at a rate of \$2.09 cents per mile, the Board of Education hereby establishes \$2.71 per mile as the rate to be charged when leasing District vehicles to any organization. The organization is also responsible for selecting the bus driver per the CSEA collective bargaining agreement and for paying said driver. They are also responsible for paying any outside fuel purchases.

For lease purposes to BOCES, the Board of Education establishes the rate of \$2.07 per mile.

For safety purposes, the Board of Education may approve the use of school buses instead of private vehicles for an activity involving Wayland-Cohocton students sponsored through an extraclassroom activity fund or an outside organization like a booster club. For that purpose, the Board establishes the rate of per mile with the group responsible for fuel and driver cost.
