The Education Committee meeting was called to order at 6:45. A document about the Education Committee objectives and practices was distributed by Academic Director Elise Foxall. Meetings would involve informing, discussing and/or brainstorming at the committee level. The document could be shared with future boards and Education Committees. Different topics would be covered at monthly meetings.

How can the district inform parents and the community about school activities and performance? The August meeting can be used to formulate this annual communication plan.

The Education Committee can be used to both make recommendations to the Board and as a forum for Board concerns. Advance information for meeting topics would be distributed by the Academic Director to Committee members in advance.

The Committee discussed priorities and interaction between the Committee and the Board such as work on the Strategic Plan and updating policies that are pertinent to the Education Committee.

The Academic Director commented about considerations about the future of math, reading and technology programs at the school. Goal setting, priorities, delegation and measuring success for instruction and student education were discussed. The Academic Director informed the Board members about how she keeps up to date with instructional practices and philosophies in education.
