Dear Parents and Guardians:

We are continuing to monitor the coronavirus (now named COVID-19) situation. Currently there are no known cases in Siskiyou County. As a reminder, if your child is sick please keep them home from school. To help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including the coronavirus and the flu, follow these important tips:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. An alcohol based hand sanitizer is also effective.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact whenever possible with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue into the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces around your home.
- Individuals experiencing severe symptoms, especially those with chronic health issues, should be evaluated by medical professionals.
- The California Department of Public Health does not recommend the use of face masks as a general protection stating that frequent handwashing is actually more effective.
