

Q: How do I log in to the web site?

A: You can log in from any page on the web site. Simply enter your user name and password in the designated boxes and submit. If you don't already have a user name or password, click the "Register here" link to complete a quick registration process.

Q: What if I have trouble logging in to the web site or I don't have Internet access?

A: You can check your benefits, eligibility and claim information on our interactive voice response telephone line or speak to a Customer Service representative Monday through Friday by calling Delta Dental toll-free. For DeltaCare USA enrollees, please call 800-422-4234. For Delta Dental PPOSM and Premier® enrollees, please use the numbers listed at the left to contact Customer Service.

O: Can I contact Customer Service on the web site?

A: Yes. You don't have to log in to contact Customer Service from our web site. Simply click on "Contact us" at the top of the home page and follow the appropriate links for your plan. You'll be presented with a number of contact options, including online Customer Service request forms for specific issues as well as the toll-free telephone number for your plan.

Q: How can I check on the average cost of a dental procedure in my area?

A: Log in by entering your user name and password (on the home page or any page on the web site) and click on "Fee Finder" in the main navigation menu.

Q: How current is the information on the web site?

A: The "Find a Dentist" directory is updated weekly. The "Eligibility & Benefits" records are refreshed nightly and reflect any updates made the previous day. All other information on the web site is updated as needed.

Set up an online account

Get information about your plan anytime, anywhere by signing up for an online account at deltadentalins.com. This free service, available once your coverage kicks in, lets you check benefits and eligibility information, find a network dentist and more.

Check in without an ID card

You don't need a Delta Dental ID card when you visit the dentist. Just provide your name, birth date and enrollee ID or social security number. If your family members are covered under your

plan, they will need your information. Prefer to take a paper or electronic ID card with you? Simply log in to your account, where you can view or print your card with the click of a button.

Coordinate dual coverage

If you're covered under two plans, ask your dental office to include information about both plans with your claim, and we'll handle the rest.

Understand transition of care

Did you start on a dental treatment plan before your PPO coverage kicked in? Generally, multistage procedures are only covered under your current plan if treatment began after your plan's effective date of coverage.4 You can find this date by logging in to your online account.

In this incentive plan, Delta Dental pays 70% of the PPO contract allowance for covered diagnostic, preventive and basic services and 70% of the PPO contract allowance for major services during the first year of eligibility. The coinsurance percentage will increase by 10% each year (to a maximum of 100%) for each enrollee if that person visits the dentist at least once during the year. If an enrollee does not use the plan during the calendar year, the percentage remains at the level attained the previous year. If an enrollee becomes ineligible for benefits and later regains eligibility, the percentage will drop back to 70%.
