### **Consortium Services**

MD—\$35,388.30 per pupil

SCU—\$52,590.20 per pupil

### **Professional Development**

The cost for professional development for member districts depends on the nature of the professional development. Whenever possible, it is provided for free. If necessary, a nominal fee is charged, and that fee is based on the cost incurred for the program. For example, for an all-day summer professional development program offered to administrators of Miami County schools in August of 2019, districts were charged from \$75. The school that hosted the session was offered the discounted fee for its staff.

### **Administrative Searches**

The Miami County Educational Service Center has assisted Miami County districts upon request in their search for treasurers or superintendents at no cost.

### **Specialized Services**

OT costs for students not in consortium units—\$476 per day

SLP costs for students not in consortium units—\$504 per day.

Hearing interpreting services—\$35-\$51 per hour depending on benefit choices of staff

Attendance officer—Districts that request this service are charged \$102.32 per hour

Intervention technology services—\$46.06 per hour

Curriculum services—\$565.60-\$640.72 per day

Talented and Gifted Coordination Services—\$255.94 per day

Home Instruction Teachers—\$26.71-\$38.03 per hour

Fingerprinting services—\$30 for BCII and \$35 for FBI

Resident Educator Program—Cost to districts depends on Resident Educator Grant funds

Excellence in Education Banquet—Free

Annual bus driver professional development—Free

Hosting of professional meetings—Free

The Miami County Educational Service Center hires other positions requested by school districts at a pay rate that is negotiated with those districts.

To cover the administrative costs associated with these positions, an administrative fee is charged at the rate of 4.5%
