Early Childhood Screening

Screening is recommended for children 3 1/2-5 years of age. Minnesota law requires a health and developmental screening at least once before starting school district school readiness, early childhood special education, or kindergarten. Trained professionals will check vision; hearing; language and communication; immunizations; and large and small muscle, cognitive, social and emotional development. If

there are questions or concerns, parents/guardians are informed of resources for further assistance or evaluation. Early identification is very helpful in preventing health and learning problems from becoming more serious, but it is not intended as a substitute for health care from your family physician, dentist, or other providers.

4-H Small Animal Fitting and Showing Clinic

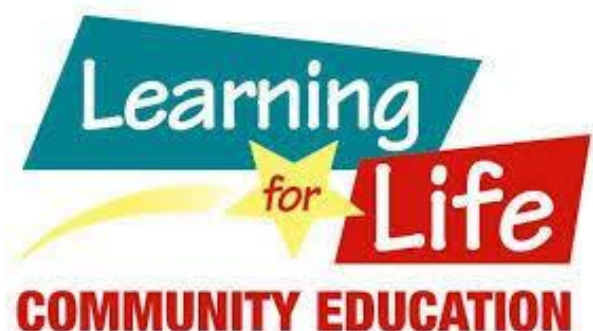

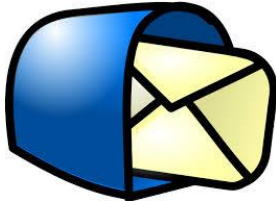

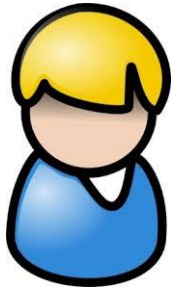
