

**Robert S. and Alice W. Longworth

For Hicksville High School**

Established in 1997 with the first scholarship awarded in 1998

**CRITERIA:**

- 1) Amount of scholarship: \$750.00 (amended in 2015)
- 2) Once applicant receives the scholarship, he/she becomes a recipient; and as a first or second semester freshman recipient, is eligible to apply for the award for a one-time renewal and his/her application will be considered along with the other applicants for the year.
- 3) Applicant must be a resident of the school district designated as Hicksville High School, and a graduating, college-bound senior, OR a recipient of the award the previous year.  
Note: In the event that the Hicksville High School ceases to exist or consolidates, applicant must be a resident of Hicksville Township
- 4) Applicant must rank in the top 10% of his/her class (high school or college/university/professional school) at the time of application.
- 5) Applicant must have earned at least one varsity letter in a sport played through and for Hicksville High School, or its equivalent if HHS ceases to exist.
- 6) Applicant/recipient must demonstrate that the/he has been committed to community service throughout his/her high school years (freshman-senior).
- 7) Applicant will provide a transcript, with proof of class ranking, with the application.
- 8) Application form will include standard identifying information (name, address, age, etc.) team sports played, varsity letters won, other extra-curricular activities (yearbook, school newspaper, drama club, Quiz Bowl, band, chorus, etc.) and community service activities.

Application may be obtained from the Hicksville High School Guidance Counselor's office March 15<sup>th</sup> and must be returned to that office no later than April 15<sup>th</sup>.

Application will include a typed statement by the candidate of 250-300 words analyzing his/her strengths and weaknesses (re: the academic, athletic and service criteria) and outlining his/her goals and objectives for college and beyond.

Application will be accompanied by at least two, but no more than three, letters of recommendation written by persons qualified to speak to the applicant's academic and athletic abilities and his/her services to the greater community. (Superintendent, principal, guidance counselor and family members are excluded from the recommending process.)
