Mr. Haugen has helped us through two full years and has tried to prepare us for the trials and tribulations we will now encounter in our daily lives.


To us, he is the embodiment of a truly dedicated teacher. His ability to be a teacher in school and yet to become a "regular fellow" out of school has made him a friend to all.
