Parent Right-to-Know

If you have questions about the professional qualifications of your child's teacher or paraprofessional, please contact the school principal who will provide a response.

Parents may also request information on the level of achievement of the their child in each of the state academic assessments from the school principal.

District and school accountability reports from the Kansas State Department of Education can be found on the homepage of the district and school websites under Accountability Reports.

Homeless students are permitted to continue attending their schools of origin for the duration of their homeless experience until the end of any academic year in which they move into permanent housing. School of origin is defined as:

- The school that the child or youth attended when permanently housed; or
- The school in which the child or youth was last enrolled.

Transportation to the school of origin, at the request of the parent or guardian, will be provided. In the case of an unaccompanied youth, transportation will be provided at the request of the district's local homeless education liaison, located at the Newcomer Center, 615 West 7th.
