- 4. Minimum of two letters of reference from people not related to the applicant.

Interview

Each applicant may be scheduled for an interview with the Lions Club Scholarship Committee by the scholarship coordinator.

Selection of Recipient

Selection of the grant recipient will be based on information contained in the application and obtained at the interview.

The scholarship, in the amount of \$500, will be awarded at the same time as other scholarships. Payment of the award will be made directly to the school of the students' choice upon receipt of verification of enrollment from the registrars' office (submit verification to the address listed below.
