3.	Address Learning Loss	-Hire 3 full time tutors to address learning deficitsHold summer intervention programs for students -Purchase Curriculum and software needed to aid in promoting learning -Provide credit recovery services
4.	Maintaining Safe Facilities	-Upgrade HVAC systems to ensure air circulation -Purchase handwashing stations - Hire an additional School Resource Officer to maintain student safety.
5.	Transportation	-Purchase an additional school bus.
