Registration is by invitation only.

Get a jump on high school! Earn .5 high school elective credit and learn how to be successful in high school. This is a great opportunity to get ahead now that Core24 is a graduation requirement.

The Summer Bridge to High School course will feature AVID-style coursework around academic language, rigor, and focused organization. Students will receive a planner and an early connection to staff and students at the high school where they will attend. A field trip will take place during the final week of the program to the high school campuses for students to familiarize themselves with the area.

The Summer Bridge to High School course requires commitment – student will be dropped after 3 absences.

When and Where?

- **Monday through Thursday – June 29th – July 2nd**
- **Monday through Friday – July 6th – July 17th**
- School – Marysville Middle School
- School schedules will be as follows:
 - Class – 8:00am – 11:45am
 - Lunch – Staggered
 - Dismissal – 11:45am

What does it cost?

- The **Summer Bridge to High School** course is free for families, paid through state and federal grants.

What about meals and transportation?

- Breakfast and lunch are included for all students.
- **Transportation will be provided** - If assigned school is not within walking distance from your home
- **If you currently reside outside of the district boundaries**, transportation to summer school will be the family's responsibility.

Who is eligible?

- Existing 8th grade students from any middle school who are identified by school staff or families as needing assistance to prepare for high school. **Again, registration is by invitation only.**
